

## SPECIAL MEETING

September 25, 2019

A special meeting of the Town Board was held at 1:00 pm September 25, 2019 for the purpose of interviewing for the Assessor position and to review an application for a building addition by ASK in an Industrial District.

Board members present were Dan Acton, Bill Cleveland, Matthew Snyder and Jerry Snyder.

Absent was Fion MacCrea. Others present were Bobbi Elderkin, Stephen Simons and Shannon Forsythe of ASK Chemicals LLC and Town Clerk Janice Burdick.

A motion to go to Executive Session to discuss employment of a particular person was made by Bill Cleveland, second by Matthew Snyder and carried 4-0. A motion to leave Executive Session at 1:30 pm was made by Dan Acton, seconded by Jerry Snyder and carried 4-0.

ASK Chemicals Zoning Application for a 17' x 30' x 12' structure to store wastewater treatment processing on Shaw Road, Alfred Station. Mr. Simons reported that they currently haul the wastewater to Bath but they will no longer take it due to clogging. Currently the Village of Alfred is taking it but this will create a long term plan to put in a filter press that will take care of it. Have a similar one at their other site. When asked what is in the sludge, Mr. Simon responded Zirconium Alumina and oxide water and noted that it is non-hazardous. Mr. Acton asked how much water they use and was told about 10,000 gallons. Matthew Snyder stated that once it is pressed what will be hauled to the landfill. It will be a solid cube and they have looked at recycling options. Will be able to reuse the water which will be in a large holding tank. They have their own well plus use Village water. Need Village water for sprinkler system. The Village may take the water once it is filtered out and can no longer be used by them. Hope to have in place by end of year and waiting for paperwork from corporate offices for funding. Currently have 86 fulltime employees with 4 temps. Also, they ship worldwide with 60% domestic and 40% overseas.

A motion was made by Matthew Snyder to approve the Zoning permit. Seconded by Dan Acton and carried 4-0.

A motion to hire Bobbi Elderkin to a 6 year term beginning October 1, 2019 as Assessor was made by Dan Acton seconded by Bill Cleveland and carried 4-0. Her hours will be Wednesdays 11-1:00 and provide quarterly reports. It was noted that Jayna DeGroff has not showed up for work in 2 weeks and attempts to contact her have failed.

A motion to adjourn at 1:50 pm was made by Matthew Snyder seconded by Bill Cleveland and carried 4-0.
