Digging into the grant opportunity listed below.

The CARES Act funding has to be related to COVID relief in some way & the community must be income eligible, which the Village already is.

So HVAC related activities for air quality, potentially emergency generators if can tie to COVID. Building improvements to reduce the spread of COVID. The CARES rounds are on-going. A letter of intent is sent in to OCR, they have a call with the community and then if they feel the project is acceptable a full application is put in. Applications received by the 1st Friday of the month will go to OCR's board the following month for review/approval. Funds can be given rather quickly.

Fire trucks and ambulances are eligible but you must prove that they are for COVID related activities and must be income eligible. Communities must demonstrate why they need a new Truck or Ambulance It can't be just because they want one. If replacing an old truck, the old truck must

be past it's useful life or not able to pass inspection or no longer suited to the needs of the community in COVID responses. If a new truck/ambulance (not replacing an old one) the application has to demonstrate why the new truck/ambulance is needed.

They have not been able to spend all of the COVID \$\$ so if a connection can be made that is reasonable, they would probably go for it.
